Confirm Eligibility

To be eligible for the Wheelchair Recycling Program, your child must:

- Not have coverage through private insurance or another public program;
- Be a permanent resident of Nova Scotia;
- Have a valid Nova Scotia Health insurance number;
- Provide proof of income and Notice of Assessment from the Canada Revenue Agency (CRA);
- Provide a prescription from an occupational Therapist or other health care professional;
- Provide two quotes explaining the prescription needs;
- Be considered to have a palliative condition;
- Eligible for Nursing Support Services Direct Care; OR
- Diagnosed with one of the following degenerative conditions: Duchenne Muscular Dystrophy; Spinal Muscular Atrophy Type 2.



Fill out the Application

The first step is to download and print the Application form. You can find the Application Form [Here \(PDF\)](#). You will need to ask your Occupational Therapist to complete Section C of the form. You will also need to get two quotes for the wheelchair you want. If you have another health insurance policy you will need to attach that policy to your application
