

The Low Income Pharmacare for Children
Application Process



Confirm Eligibility

To be eligible for the LIPC, you must qualify for the Nova Scotia Child Benefit. Families who are not eligible through the Nova Scotia Child Benefit may be eligible for coverage under the Nova Scotia Family Pharmacare Program from the Department of Health and Wellness.



Apply for the LIPC

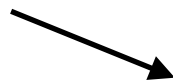


Approval

If approved, you will receive a letter saying so, and how much you will receive.

Rejection

If rejected you will receive a letter saying so that outlines the appeals process.



Use the Pharmacare Program

Once approved you can use their Nova Scotia healthcare as a pharmacare card until the child turns 18, without having to re-apply.
